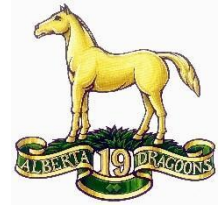

Officer Report:

Drill team has been withdrawn from the Kozar Cup. To be reconsidered next year.

March 20/24: Wandering Dragoons FTX at Elk Island Provincial Park.

May 16/24: Practice Mess dinner. This is to teach cadets how to behave, dress, and interact during a formal Mess dinner- plan to resume formal Mess dinners in the coming cadet year. Potluck vs catering TBD.

May 25/24: Orienteering Day at Rundle Park. This will be a joint event with the local Sea Cadet corps (100+ cadets will be in attendance).

June 6/24: Final practice prior to ACR. All promotions and star level qualifications will be given so cadets will have time to sew badges on formal uniforms prior to ACR. If there are any volunteers that are willing to help with sewing, please let Cyndy know.

June 15/24: Annual Ceremonial Review (ACR). Will be a full day event with the cadets dropped off in the morning to practice drill and set up. Potentially booking the community center or gym as a backup in case of bad weather and to ensure there is enough space for everyone to attend. Potluck vs barbecue TBD.

There is ongoing work on next year's training schedule. Plan to have special teams training for one period, cadets may choose to attend if they would like. Question about whether the preference is for the first hour or the last- parents present at meeting prefer special teams training during the last hour of practice.

All cadets choosing to attend summer training have completed their applications. Offers will be emailed to cadet's 365 accounts starting in mid-May. Cadets are responsible for checking their 365 accounts to monitor for their offer and respond as soon as possible. The corp is not being notified of offers so this really falls to the cadets to be watching their 365 accounts.
